



**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
ON THE ACADEMIC COLLABORATION PROGRAM
BETWEEN**

**STIEKN JAYA NEGARA
AND
NATIONAL TAIPEI UNIVERSITY OF NURSING AND HEALTH SCIENCES, TAIWAN**

National Taipei University of Nursing and Health Sciences, Taiwan and STIEKN Jaya Negara, recognize the benefits of developing a collegial relationship between our respective colleges to establish strong international links. To this aim, we propose the following agreement:

1. The purpose of this agreement are to develop academic collaboration, and to promote a joint relationship between NTUNHS and STIEKN Jaya Negara.
2. Both institutions undertake to promote and develop cooperation in the following ways, on a basic of equality and reciprocity.
 - a. Exchange of student program
 - b. Collaborative of student learning
 - c. Collaborative of academic staff members training
 - d. Mutual assistance in the preparation of seminar, conferences and workshops.
 - e. Exchange of academic publication materials or other information
 - f. Join research
 - g. Co-operation in training projects for specified area of development
3. To implement these forms for cooperation, representatives of our individual institution will be encouraged to consult with each other and to develop specific plans for collaboration in any or all of the ways outlined in the agreement two above.
4. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of cooperation stated in the agreement two shall depend on our mutual availability of resources and financial support from our individual institutions.
5. This agreement will come into effect on the date when the representative of both institutions sign the agreement and will remain valid from period of three years. The agreement may be extended after discussion with representatives of both institutions. Such discussion needs to comment not later six months before the termination of the agreement.
6. This agreement may be revised or modified within that period by mutual consent. Similarly, the agreement may be terminated within the period by either party providing six months' notice is given to the other.

The evaluation will be conducted by NTUNHS and STIEKN Jaya Negara after two years implementations of this MoA.

ANNEX : Details of Collaboration Activities

- a. The maximum of 3 students will be exchanged between institutions for each year
- b. The maximum of 3 academic staff will be exchanged between institutions for each year of any regular or customized program.
- c. Both institutions agree to provide tuition discount or tuition waive for the student exchange program, and students/academic staffs training if any available funding.
- d. Period of exchange and training are one month in maximum
- e. STIEKN Jaya Negara may send undergraduate/Master/Ph.D students who fulfill the requirements to study at NTUNHS with scholarships facility from NTUNHS and other available scholarship from third party.
